## **ORDINANCE NO. 328**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 69 "PARKING REGULATIONS", SECTION 69.08 (1) "PARKING OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLES", OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NORWAY, IOWA"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORWAY, IOWA:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Code of Ordinances of the City of Norway, Iowa is hereby amended to repeal and replace, Section 69.08 (1) Parking of Recreational Vehicles, set forth in Chapter 69, Traffic and Vehicles, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Norway, Iowa.

Section 2. 69.08 (1) PARKING OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLES is hereby amended to read as follows:

1. It is unlawful to park a boat trailer, utility trailer, or unoccupied motor home, travel trailer, or camping trailer, on any public street, alley or place in excess of 24 hours in any thirty (30) day period. Upon application to the City Council, emergency or temporary parking for occupied travel trailers, campers and motor homes may be permitted at designated locations on public streets, alleys, or any other public or private place for a three-day period, subject to extended time of up to three days upon reapplication, and subject to any other prohibitions or regulations imposed by traffic and parking ordinances of the City.

<u>Section 3.</u> All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 4.</u> If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance is adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional.

<u>Section 5.</u> This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after passage and approval and publication as provided by law.
