Council Meeting Minutes

Regular meeting of the Norway City Council was called to order by Mayor Jim Nelson at 5:30 PM. Roll Call – Present: Darrell Schulte, Shawn Rudie, Christopher Van Horn, Mike Schulte, & Robby Miller. Absent: None.

Motion by C. Van Horn to approve the agenda, minutes, & bills, as presented, excluding the bill from Pomp's Tire Service for Tire Repair on a firetruck as the invoice will be paid by Norway Area Firefighter's Association. Seconded by D. Schulte. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by C. Van Horn to pass and approve Resolution 26-01 – Approving an increase in the City Clerk's Wages. Seconded by S. Rudie. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by C. Van Horn to pass and approve Resolution 26-02 – Setting the time, date, and place for a public hearing for the purpose of considering the maximum property tax levy for the proposed fiscal year 2026-2027 budget for March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2026, at 5:30pm in the Norway Public Library. Seconded by M. Schulte. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by C. Van Horn to approve including garbage rate differences into the proposed fiscal year 2026 budget amendment. Seconded by D. Schulte. Motion carried 5-0.

Garbage and recycling service was discussed. Please look for additional updates as they become available.

The city is seeking an as needed public works assistant. Please contact City Hall with any interest.

Motion by S. Rudie to pass and approve the second reading of Ordinance Amendment No. 353- Amending Chapter 155.03 'Building Permit Issuance' – To include the requirement of a permit for permanent generators. Seconded by C. Van Horn. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by S. Rudie to waive the third and final reading of Ordinance Amendment No. 353. Seconded by C. Van Horn. Motion carried 5-0.

Ordinance Amendment No. 353 passes and is adopted. Ayes: 5. Nays: 0.

Motion by C. Van Horn to table the first reading of Ordinance No. 354 – Amending Chapter 3.03 'Municipal Infractions' – Civil Penalties, until the next meeting. Seconded by M. Schulte. Motion carried 5-0.

Maggie Burger, who is serving as the City's financial advisor with Speer Financial, was present via video call to present the water revenue pro forma review results to the council.

Motion by C. Van Horn to approve selecting Bear Creek Archeology to complete an archaeological desktop review for the City of Norway regarding the upcoming water pressure booster system project. Seconded by M. Schulte. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by C. Van Horn to schedule a special city council meeting for Monday, March 2<sup>nd</sup>, at 5:30pm in the Norway Public Library. Seconded by D. Schulte. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by C. Van Horn, seconded by S. Rudie, to adjourn the meeting at 8:02 PM. Motion carried 5-0.
